

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S): REGISTRATION & LOTTERY

Q1: Can students who reside outside of Edmonton City Limits be considered in the lottery or application process? (i.e., Leduc, Sherwood Park, Beaumont, etc.)

A: Yes, however, charter yellow bus transportation will not be provided.

Q2: Will siblings be prioritized as part of the lottery process in future years?

A: Yes, applications of prospective students who already have a sibling attending the Collegiate will be given priority for spaces. We believe in keeping families together.

Q3: Are cousins considered siblings if they live at the same residential address?

A: Yes, all children living full-time under the same roof will be considered siblings.

Q4: My child will not be old enough to attend STEM Collegiate for a few years, but can I put their name on a lottery list now to be considered for a spot in the future?

A: No, the lottery for spaces will be done annually with registration applications for the next school year due at the end of January. Sign up for updates to keep informed.

Q5: I've completed the online registration form and uploaded all required documents. When can I expect to hear if my child received a spot for next fall?

A: Registration applications submitted after February 10th will be reviewed within a two-week period. You will be notified the second Friday after your submission.

Q6: If the school reaches capacity, how long does their name stay on the wait list?

A: If your child doesn't receive a spot due to school capacity, their name will stay on the wait list until the end of September.

Q7. What documents am I required to upload in the online registration system?

A: We need an electronic copy of your child's most recent report card and Individual Program Plan (IPP), if applicable. Scanned copies or photo images are accepted.
